At its regular meeting on January 9, 2017, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2D ("ANC 2D" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With 2 of 2 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (2-0-0):

The Commission approves the denial of allowing the conversion of an existing single family dwelling into a Chancery in D-R-3, but supports granting the embassy the right to continue to operate at this location without street parking for the necessary duration until the permanent quarters are rehabilitated on Massachusetts Avenue NW.
